HEALTH PROTOCOLS

The BMDCNC has planned these tests in accordance with public health requirements in place as of the publication of the premium list. The health and welfare of our exhibitors, judges, club members, and all who work to make the shows a success is paramount. By attending you agree to follow any protocols that may be in effect during the dates of this test for the state, county and/or host facility where the event is being held.

If you have any symptoms associated with COVID, RSV or the Flu, or believe you have been exposed in the 10 days before these tests to these diseases, we ask that you refrain from attending this event. If you test positive for COVID within 10 days after attending this event, we ask that you notify the Test Secretary and/or Test Chair.

WE WELCOME SPECTATORS!

Come watch the teams at work or even help out for a day – there are a lot of ways you can participate while learning more about the art of canine draft work! Unentered dogs may accompany you but must be leashed or crated and under control at all times. And please remember to always pick up after your dogs.

PROPOSED DAILY SCHEDULE

- CHECK-IN time will be determined after the close of entries. If Late Check-In is offered, eligible entrants will be notified with their entry confirmation.
- EQUIPMENT CHECK will immediately follow Check-In. All handlers must be with their rigs during Equipment Check. Equipment Check includes the draft rig, weights, harness, collar, and leash.
- JUDGES' WALK-THRU will immediately follow Equipment Check.
- JUDGING will begin as soon as possible after the Walk-Thru.
- A LUNCH BREAK will be taken each day at the judges' discretion.
- AWARDS will be presented at the conclusion of the Test each day.
- Judges will be available for AWARD PHOTOS after the presentation of Awards.
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AWARDS

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Northern California will offer a Prize and Ribbon to each qualifying Team. Rosettes will be presented for a dog's first-time title (first NDD, DD, BNDD or BDD).

Achievement Awards will also be presented to:

- Any dog earning an Advanced Draft Title
- First qualifying score of the weekend for a rescue dog
- First qualifying score of the weekend for a veteran (7 years or older) dog.

Each handler will receive a Weekend Welcome Box.

BMDCA DRAFT TEST PURPOSE

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of America Draft Tests are a series of exercises designed to develop and demonstrate the natural abilities of purebred Bernese Mountain Dogs in a working capacity involving hauling. The Bernese Mountain Dog has historically functioned as a draft dog in various capacities, and performance of these exercises is intended to demonstrate skills resulting from both inherent ability and training which are applicable to realistic work situations. Efficiency in accomplishment of tasks is essential. It is also desirable that the dog exhibit willingness and enjoyment of his work in a combination of controlled teamwork with his handler and natural independence.

CLASS ENTRY DETAILS

- There will be a limit of **28 entries** (Teams) per test.
- Entry fees are **\$38** for each single dog Team and **\$48** for each Brace Team
- A separate entry form must be filled out for each dog of a Brace Team and submitted together. Even though two entry forms are required, each Brace Team will be counted as one entry in the Draft Test entry limit.
- In each test, if more than 28 entries are received, they will be prioritized in the following order:

1. Untitled BMDs

2. Titled BMDs without Advanced/Master titles in the entered class

3. Titled BMDs with Advanced/Master titles in the entered class

3. Untitled Other Dogs

2. Titled Other Dogs without Advanced/Master titles in the entered class

3. Titled Other Dogs with Advanced/Master titles in the entered class

NOTE: For Brace Teams, the dog with the lowest level title in the entered class determines the Team's priority. If a Brace Team has a BMD and a non-BMD, it is considered a "BMD Team" in the above priority list.

NOTE: "Titled" means titled in the entered class.

- Running Order: A separate random draw to determine the running order for each class for each test.
- Entrants must notify the Draft Test Recording Secretary if a dog has earned a title in the entered class prior to the Test date, including if the title is earned after the entry has been submitted.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- The following classes will be offered: Novice, Brace Novice, Open and Brace Open.
- Handlers must provide their own rigs, harnesses, and tie downs or other means of securing a load on their particular draft rig.
- Handlers must bring their own weight. Weight will be verified via scale at the Test site.
- Entered dogs must be 24 months old or older on the day of the Draft Test.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete (see Entry Fee Refund Policy section).
- The two dogs of a Brace Team need not be owned by the same person or by the handler.
- Entered dogs not in the ring, like unentered dogs, must be leashed or crated and under control at all times.
- Please remember to be responsible dog owners and pick up after your dogs.

WEIGHT CERTIFICATES

A DWC-approved Weight Certificate (WC) form is included in this Premium List. Each Open or Open Brace entry shall include the WC or a certificate that includes the same information that is contained in the WC (available on the BMDCA website) and be signed and dated within 60 days prior to each Draft Test date. The handler is solely responsible for having a valid Weight Certificate. An incorrect Weight Certificate may result in the loss of any qualifying runs.

The ONLY acceptable Weight Certificate forms are:

1. On the BMDCA Draft Test Weight Certificate Form with clinic stamp showing clinic name and address (an attached business card is not an acceptable substitute for a clinic stamp).
2. On the Vet Clinic's Letterhead with clinic name and address (an attached business card is not an acceptable substitute for letterhead) with the same information requested on the BMDCA WC Form.

REGULATIONS

DRAFT TEST REGULATIONS: Entrants are responsible for obtaining the current edition of the BMDCA Draft Test Regulations and being familiar with them. Regulations may be downloaded from www.BMDCA.org/Draft at no charge and, if available, may be ordered from BMDCA Ways and Means (fee applies).

MISCONDUCT DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE: The BMDCA and the DWC take dog aggressions very seriously and shall investigate and penalize such incidents, including but not limited to withholding titles. By participating in or attending this Test, you understand and agree to the terms of the Misconduct Disciplinary Procedure as outlined in the current Draft Test Regulations.

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ENTRY FEE REFUND POLICIES

BITCHES IN SEASON: Entry fees will be refunded for an entered bitch who comes into season at the time of the Draft Test. For a refund, the Recording Secretary (Cindy Beckman) must be notified of a withdrawal due to a bitch in season no later than 7:00 p.m. the evening before the test.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES: Entry fees will be refunded for a dog that has a medical emergency that prevents participation in the assigned draft test upon receipt of a veterinary certificate. For a refund, the Recording Secretary (Cindy Beckman) should be notified of a withdrawal due to a medical emergency no later than 7:30 a.m. on the day of the test. Veterinary confirmation should be submitted within 7 days.

ALTERNATES: Entry fees will be refunded to an Alternate Team that is not able to run in the assigned test due to that test reaching its maximum Team limit. If an Alternate Team is moved into a test and is not present or opts not to participate, no refund will be given.

WITHDRAWALS: No refunds will be made for voluntary withdrawals or for reasons not listed above.

REFUND METHODS: An entry check will be destroyed to cancel the entry payment. A PayPal entry will be refunded directly to the payment account minus the PayPal fee.
