WE WELCOME SPECTATORS!

Come watch the teams at work or even help out for a day – there are a lot of ways you can participate while learning more about the art of canine draft work! Un-entered dogs may also be present but must be leashed or crated and under control at all times. Please show courtesy to the working dogs by keeping all dogs at a reasonable distance from the ring, and do not allow them to foul the freight haul. Please walk and potty your dogs in the designated areas, which may change each day due to the Freight Haul course layout. And remember to always pick up after your dogs.

BMDCA DRAFT TEST PURPOSE

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of America Draft Tests are a series of exercises designed to develop and demonstrate the natural abilities of purebred Bernese Mountain Dogs in a working capacity involving hauling. The Bernese Mountain Dog has historically functioned as a draft dog in various capacities, and performance of these exercises is intended to demonstrate skills resulting from both inherent ability and training which are applicable to realistic work situations. Efficiency in accomplishment of tasks is essential. It is also desirable that the dog evidence willingness and enjoyment of his work in a combination of controlled teamwork with his handler and natural independence.

REGULATIONS

Misconduct Disciplinary Procedure: The BMDCA and the DWC take dog aggressions very seriously and shall investigate and penalize such incidents, including but not limited to withholding titles. By participating in or attending this Test, you understand and agree to the terms of the Misconduct Disciplinary Procedure as outlined in the current Draft Test Regulations.

WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Animals in Distress: The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Northern California reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the clubs for such removal. The Club regards the health, safety and life of any dog on the show grounds to be paramount to other property or privacy rights. We will attempt to reach the responsible party but cannot guarantee contact will be made before action is taken.

PROPOSED DAILY SCHEDULE

- **CHECK-IN** Estimated 7:30 am, but exact time will be determined after the close of entries. If Late Check-In is offered, eligible entrants will be notified with their entry confirmation.
 - **EQUIPMENT CHECK** will immediately follow Check-In. All handlers must be with their rigs during Equipment Check. Equipment Check includes the draft rig, weights, harness, collar, and leash.
 - **JUDGES' WALK-THRU** will immediately follow Equipment Check.
 - **JUDGING** will begin as soon as possible after the Walk-Thru.
 - **A LUNCH BREAK** will be taken each day, exact time to be determined by the Camp Chefs.
 - **AWARDS** will be presented at the conclusion of the Test each day.
 - Judges will be available for **AWARD PHOTOS** after the presentation of Awards.
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AWARDS

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Northern California will offer a Prize and Ribbon to each qualifying Team. Rosette ribbons will be presented for a dog's first-time title (first NDD, DD, BNDD or BDD).

Achievement Awards will also be presented to:

- Any dog earning an Advanced Draft Title.
- First qualifying score of the weekend for a veteran (7 years or older) dog.

CLASS ENTRY DETAILS

- There will be a limit of **28 entries** (Teams) per test.
 - Entry fees are **\$38 (\$40 PayPal)** for each single dog Team and **\$48 (\$50 PayPal)** for each Brace Team
 - A separate Entry Form must be filled out for each dog of a Brace Team and submitted together. Even though two Entry Forms are required, each Brace Team will be counted as one entry in the Draft Test entry limit.
 - In each test, if more than 28 entries are received, they will be prioritized in the following order:
 1. **Untitled BMDs** in the entered class
 2. **Titled BMDs** without Advanced/Master titles in the entered class
 3. **Titled BMDs** with Advanced/Master titles in the entered class
 4. **Untitled Other Dogs** in the entered class
 5. **Titled Other Dogs** without Advanced/Master titles in the entered class
 6. **Titled Other Dogs** with Advanced/Master titles in the entered class
- NOTE:** For Brace Teams, the dog with the lowest level title in the entered class determines the Team's priority. If a Brace Team has a BMD and a non-BMD, it is considered a "BMD Team" in the above priority list.*
- NOTE:** "Titled" means titled in the entered class.*
- Running Order: A separate random draw will determine the running order for each class for each test.
 - Entrants must notify the Draft Test Recording Secretary if a dog has earned a title in the entered class prior to the Test date, including if the title is earned after the entry has been submitted.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- The following classes will be offered: Novice, Brace Novice, Open and Brace Open.
- Handlers must provide their own rigs, harnesses, and tie downs or other means of securing a load on their particular draft rig.
- Handlers must bring their own weight. Weight will be verified via scale at the Test site.
- Entered dogs must be 24 months old or older on the day of the Draft Test.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete (see Entry Fee Refund Policy section on next page).
- The two dogs of a Brace Team need not be owned by the same person or by the handler.
- Un-entered dogs may be present but, like entered dogs that are not in the ring, must be leashed or crated and under control at all times.
- Please remember to be responsible dog owners and pick up after your dogs.

WEIGHT CERTIFICATES

A DWC-approved Weight Certificate form is included in this Premium List and is also available on the BMDCA website under the Events/Draft tab. Each Open or Open Brace entry shall include the DWC Weight Certificate (or a certificate that includes the same information that is contained in the DWC Weight Certificate) and be signed and dated within 60 days prior to each Draft Test date. The handler is solely responsible for having a valid Weight Certificate. An incorrect Weight Certificate may result in the loss of any qualifying runs.

The ONLY acceptable Weight Certificate forms are:

1. On the BMDCA Draft Test Weight Certificate Form with clinic stamp showing clinic name and address (an attached business card is not an acceptable substitute for a clinic stamp).
2. On the Vet Clinic's Letterhead with clinic name and address (an attached business card is not an acceptable substitute for letterhead) with the same information requested on the BMDCA WC Form.

ENTRY FEE REFUND POLICIES

BITCHES IN SEASON: Entry fees will be refunded for an entered bitch who comes into season at the time of the Draft Test. For a refund, the Recording Secretary (Cindy Beckman) must be notified of a withdrawal due to a bitch in season no later than 7:00 p.m. the evening before the test.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES: Entry fees will be refunded for a dog that has a medical emergency that prevents participation in the assigned draft test upon receipt of a veterinary certificate. For a refund, the Recording Secretary (Cindy Beckman) should be notified of a withdrawal due to a medical emergency no later than 7:30 a.m. on the day of the test. Veterinary confirmation should be submitted within 7 days.

ALTERNATES: Entry fees will be refunded to an Alternate Team that is not able to run in the assigned test due to that test reaching its maximum Team limit. If an Alternate Team is moved into a test and is not present or opts not to participate, no refund will be given.

WITHDRAWALS: No refunds will be made for voluntary withdrawals or for reasons not listed above.
